Travel to Belgrade

Airport

The closest airport is Airport Nikola Tesla, located about 15km from the centre of Belgrade.

If you would like to use Taxi to get to the city centre from the Airport, please go to the airport Info Desk and take the taxi receipt specifying the desired destination and the price. City Center is in the Zone 2 and the price is 2200 RSD (about 20 EUR).

Alternatively, you can use one of the following options to get to the city centre:

- **A1 Mini bus**, going from the Airport to Slavija Square (Kralja Milutina Street). Ticket price is 300 RSD (about 2.5 EUR). You can buy the ticket on the bus and approximate travel time is 30 minutes. Find the timetable at the following link: <https://bgprevoz.rs/documents/images/B.jpg>
- **Public Transportation Line 72** (Route: Airport-Zeleni venac Square). For ticket options and prices see section Transportation in Belgrade. Approximate travel time is 30–40 minutes. Find the timetable at the following link: https://gsp.rs/dokumenti/dnevne_linije/linije-pdf/72.pdf (second page)

Transportation in Belgrade

Once you get to the City Centre, you can reach most places by foot, or by using public transport system of buses, trams and trolleys. The public transport company in Belgrade is GSP <http://www.gsp.rs> Rechargeable Belgrade smart cards (Beogradska kartica) can be bought (250 RSD) and topped up (89 RSD per ticket/ride) at kiosks. Tickets are 150 RSD if you buy from the driver. On the validator in the bus you can use Mastercard (98 RSD per ticket/ride) instead of smart cards. Fares are valid for 90 minutes.

Unlimited Belgrade card passes are available for 1 day (250 RSD), 3 days (700 RSD) or 5 days (1000 RSD) and can be bought at kiosks.

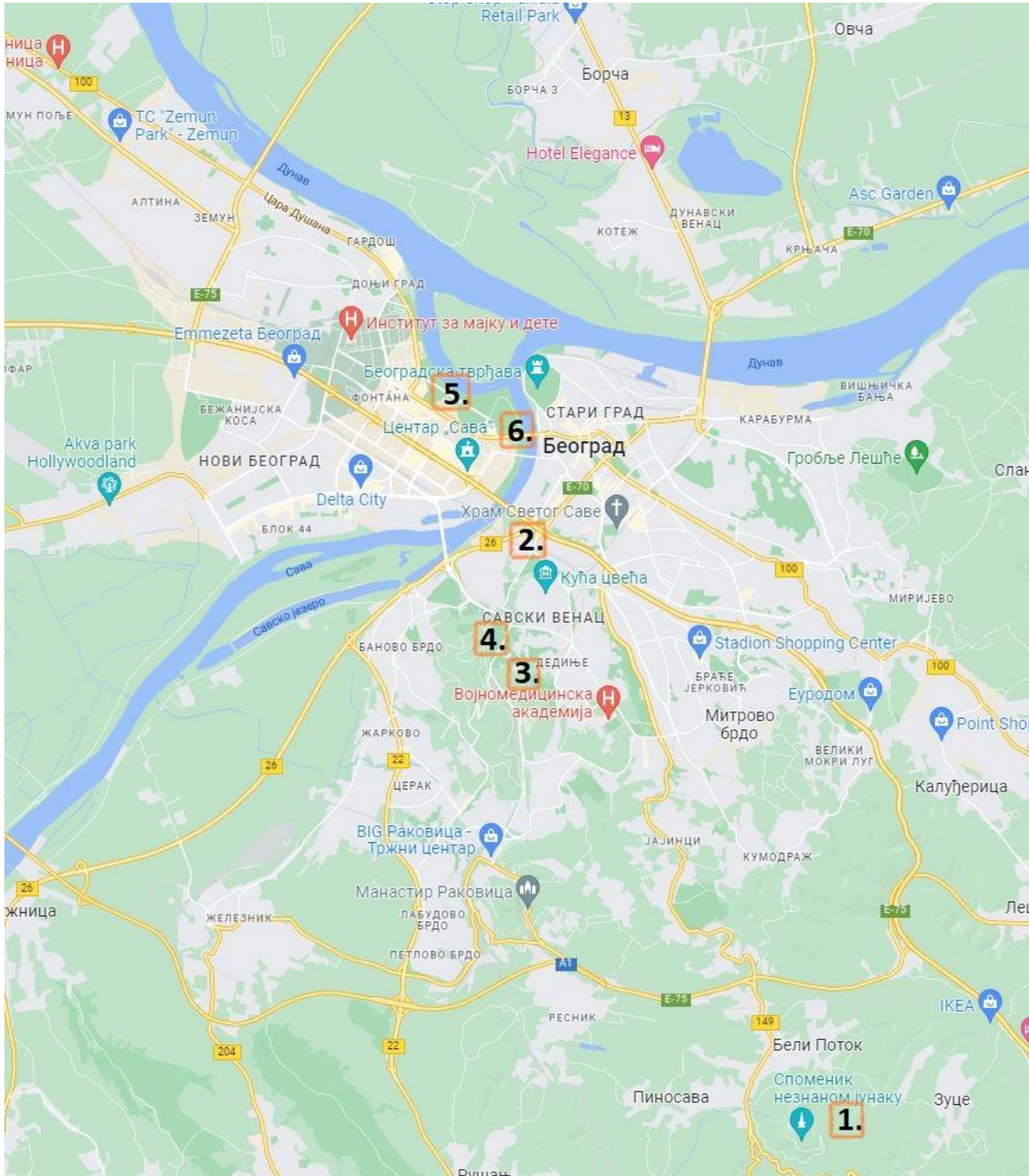
